Bishop Martin Gordon, Goma DRC.

CMS Mission partner

A newsletter from CMS and the opportunity to link into a conference call with Bishop Martin brings updates on the situation in the Eastern DRC around Goma where the conflict has been somewhat overshadowed by other world events.

The impact of the incursion of the M23 rebels has, in Bishop Martin's words, been 'unspeakably awful. Up to 8,000 people dying in the streets, hospitals overwhelmed, food scarce and widespread looting'

He launched the Goma call for Peace with other church leaders and youth organisations. He used a preplanned opportunity to visit the States and speak to the UN and US government

He asks for prayer:

- Immediate ceasefire and withdrawal of uninvited troops from eastern DRC
- Unrestricted humanitarian access and protection of civilians
- Negotiations to lead to a lasting peace in DRC
- Wisdom and courage to church leaders as they seek to rebuild schools, churches. Lives and communities after the conflict.
